Introduction

The Centre for Democracy and Development (CDD), in collaboration with the West African Civil Society Forum (WACSOF), held a two-day capacity-building workshop on ECOWAS Early Warning Mechanism at the Hotel Palm Beach, Ouagadougou, Burkina Faso, on 13th and 14th December,

2006. The Workshop, which was organized within the framework of the *West African Security Sector Transformation* of the African Security Sector Network (ASSN), is part of a broader project funded by the UK Department for International Development (DFID) through ASSN.

The central objective of the workshop was to train WACSOF focal points and national civil society coalitions in the various ECOWAS member states and to strengthen their capacities to understand, anticipate, monitor and forecast governance challenges and potential conflict triggers with a view to contributing to ECOWAS Early Warning Mechanism. The workshop was organized to:

- Create a forum for WACSOF (zonal national) focal persons in the 15 ECOWAS member states to exchange views on how best to work for sustainable peace in the West Africa, and
- Develop an acceptable action plan/framework of agenda with necessary benchmarks and indicators that will enhance their capacity to perform their roles.

The workshop witnessed several paper presentations including the one by the Director of Observation and Monitoring Centre (OMC) at the ECOWAS Commission, Col. Yoro Kone. There were robust debate and critical review (at both working group and plenary sessions) of the ECOWAS Early Warning benchmarks and indicators (94 altogether) which Col. Kone had informed participants were being piloted for two years before final review and adoption by ECOWAS. It is on this basis that the workshop reviewed, synthesised and reduced the indicators to 41, covering four thematic areas. Since the Ouagadougou Workshop CDD has shared these restructured and more user-friendly indicators in its zonal consultations and capacity building work with WACSOF national focal points and the ECOWAS Zonal Bureaux. In the process, the indicators have been further revised and sharpened into 41 in line with comments received from participants at those events.

It is in the context of the foregoing that they are being proposed to ECOWAS for adoption as its Conflict Early Warning benchmarks and indicators at the expiration of the two-year pilot period. It is our expectation that they will be received as a genuine contribution by CDD (in collaboration with WACSOF), through the ASSN, to the realization of sustainable peace and security in West Africa.

The adoption of the ECOWAS Conflict Prevention Framework is an opportunity for civil society to engage our regional organisation and states in a more active programme of early warning and early response to conflict. These indicators will be useful in this regard.
